


## Proposal to Suspend a Programme

<b>2. Award and Title of programme</b>  MSc IN CRIMINOLOGY AND JUSTICE (SSPT33 F/T & SSPT34 P/T)
<b>3. Proposed date of last intake before suspension</b>  28th SEPTEMBER 2009
<b>4. Proposed date of next intake (when recruitment resumed) *</b>  3rd OCTOBER 2011 (if possible, depending on staff availability)
<b>5. Reasons for suspension of programme</b>  The criminology programme has lost 2 members of staff, and until the posts are filled, it is necessary to concentrate remaining staff expertise onto the UG programme in this field.
<b>6. Implications for existing students</b>  No implications. This is a one-year programme and the cohort will graduate in the current academic year.
<b>7. Implications for applicants to the programme and/or those accepted for admission to the programme. If a programme is being suspended part way through an admissions cycle, due to exceptional circumstances, has the appropriate Admissions Office been consulted?</b>  Only one student has been offered a place on this programme, and that person has been offered a place on another programme. Apart from that, the recruitment has ceased.
