

Ordinance XXV

Title of Emeritus Professor

(Version effective from 15 July 2003 to 31 July 2009)

1. The Senate may recommend to Council that the title of Emeritus Professor be conferred upon any person who at the time of his/her retirement under the provisions of Ordinance XII holds or has held the full-time appointment of Professor in the University. This title is an honour in the gift of the University. There is no appeal process should the University decide not to award this title.

2. Any person upon whom the title Emeritus Professor has been conferred shall be a Life Member of the Court. No other rights, benefits or privileges are automatically attached to the award. Any benefits or privileges that might be agreed by the Head of Department and that incur costs to the Department or University will be subject to annual review by the relevant Head of Department.
