

PGCE / MSc in Education with QTS

The first year of this four year programme leads to **PGCE and Qualified Teacher Status** involving full time study. Years two to four are part time involving **e-learning**, completed at the University and the teacher's school or college.

PGCE / QTS involves 36 weeks full time study: 12 weeks in University and 24 weeks in schools. Modules are Professional studies in either science or design and technology, and General Professional Studies.

NQT Year and Induction module involves submission of a critical and reflective commentary on evidence for meeting the Induction Standards.

Enquiries to enter Year 2 from other PGCE 'M' level courses are welcome.

Advanced Pedagogy and Practitioner Research modules involve exploring innovations at the cutting edge of research, and studying and applying research methodology.

The **Research Project** module involves identifying a professional issue for exploration, designing and carrying out research on the issue. The key aim is to interrogate critically own and other's practice in teaching.
