

# **Loughborough University Terms and Conditions of Study** 2017/18: Changes from 2016 version

#### **Definitions**

Clarification that Section 1 applies to students submitting an application for a programme for the 2017/18 academic year, or the 2018/18 academic year if applying for deferred entry (subject to changes up to 30 September 2017).

Clarification that Section 2 applies to students registered on programmes in the 2017/18 academic year.

#### Section 1

#### 1.2 Your Offer of a Place

Addition of a sentence setting out the expectation that students will be in attendance at the University on the first day of term to start their course.

#### 1.3 Conditional Offers

Addition of word 'Service' after Disclosure and Barring.

Addition of a deadline of 6 September for applicants to postgraduate taught programmes to meet all conditions of their offer.

### 1.5 Status for Tuition Fee Purposes

Clarification that changes to tuition fee category can only be considered after an offer is accepted if there is a good reason why relevant circumstances were not drawn to our attention or submitted at the time the offer was accepted.

#### 1.6 Change of Circumstances

Inclusion of sentence to explain that the University reserves the right to withdraw an offer if information is revealed that may present a risk to the student, other members of the University or the University as a whole.

#### Section 2

#### 2.1 Registration

Addition of requirement for students to commit themselves fully to engage with their studies and only seek leave of absence for genuine mitigating circumstances.

#### 2.2 The Student Charter, Student Conduct and Behaviour

Addition of paragraph to explain that the University reserves the right to suspend a student's studies if information is revealed that a student's continued registration may present a risk to the student, other members of the University or the University as a whole, while fitness to study or disciplinary procedures are conducted.

## 2.6 Tuition Fees and Other Charges

Addition of paragraph to explain that tuition fees for continuing students may rise each academic year by a factor to allow for inflation, and that students will be notified of changes to tuition fees in advance.
