<b>What</b>	<b>Where</b>
Purple recycling sack	Kerbside
Green recycling box	Kerbside
White Mind sack	Kerbside
Large items (eg furniture)	Kerbside
Bagged rubbish (not in recycling sacks)	St Peter's Community Centre car park

Regular collections of refuse and recycling will continue as normal throughout the summer.

Please don't... put rubbish, bulky items or furniture out next to your bin on your normal collection day, as you could be fined. After 19th June, these items can be taken to the **tip at Railway Terrace, Loughborough**, or visit [www.charnwood.gov.uk](http://www.charnwood.gov.uk) for more options.

### **Before you leave for the summer...**

- Take your bin and recycling box back to your storage point
- Ensure your garden is clear of rubbish
- Don't leave any rubbish, recycling, furniture etc on the street – if you do, you could be fined.
