

Terms and Conditions of Study 2023/24: Changes from 2022/23 version

Section 1: Terms and Conditions for Applicants

1.2 Your Offer of a Place

Clarification provided to indicate attendance is expected in person.

1.8 Accuracy of the Information in Your Application

Clarification provided regarding postgraduate taught applicants found to have made false statements and/or provided fraudulent or plagiarised information during the admissions process will not be eligible for a refund on any CAS deposit paid.

1.12 Changes to Postgraduate Degree Programmes

Clarification that supervisors may request a change in supervisory responsibilities where they have good grounds for doing so.

1.13 Right to Study in the UK and Funding Your Studies

Clarification provided regarding what students are agreeing to when accepting an offer.

1.17 Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies for Student Visa

New section added detailing the deposit postgraduate taught students requiring a visa to study in the UK must pay before a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) document is issued to them.

Section 2 – Terms and Conditions for Registered Students

2.4 Academic Requirements and Regulations

Wording on the consequence of late submission of coursework amended to reflect revised University policy.

Wording on requirement for evidence to support Mitigating Circumstances claims amended to reflect revised University policy.

Information added to advise that the conferral date of the final academic award may change where reassessment is required. In the case of students on a Student/Tier 4 visa, the University is not able to amend assessment processes or timescales to facilitate eligibility to apply for the Graduate Route.

2.7 Tuition Fees and Other Charges

Revisions made to provide greater clarity on tuition fees and other charges including when they must be paid, the approach used to calculate inflationary increases, the implications of non-payment of tuition fees and procedures relating to debt recovery.

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2.11 Ownership of Intellectual Property

Wording amended to provide greater clarity regarding the cross reference to paragraph 2.8.

2.18 Notices

Information added about the University's expectation that students check their University email account at least once a week. Any communication sent by the University to a student's University email account will be regarded as properly sent and received.
