

## KS5 Achieve activity

### Learning objectives

By the end of this lesson students should be able to:

- Reflect on their education journey to date, identifying key milestones
- Feel confident about their own post 18 choices and ambitions
- Articulate their journey by creating their own reflective piece based on the format of the student blogs/vlogs
- Develop planning, communication and creativity skills.

The session supports activity working towards **Gatsby benchmarks 3, 4 and 7.**

Teaching Sequence	Activities	Resources	Delivery Notes
<b>Introduction (10 mins)</b>	<p>Introduce task – students are asked to create their own blog/vlog that focuses on an aspect of their education journey to date that they believe has been instrumental in shaping their ambitions. They may choose to address:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Key milestones in their education to date and how they believe these may have shaped future goals</li> <li>- The course area that they are choosing to pursue at university and why they have selected this particular subject</li> <li>- The real-world application of their course, has this influenced their decision to pursue this degree?</li> <li>- Their future career ambitions, how has their learning to date prepared them for this? Has it helped developed core knowledge and/or skills?</li> <li>- An aspect of their future that they are particularly excited about</li> </ul>	<p>Access to the LUDUS Website</p>	<p>All blog content can be accessed by blind/partially sighted students using a screen reader.</p> <p>All vlogs have captions enabled for students with hearing impairments</p>

	Utilise the Ludus blogs/vlogs to introduce techniques – snappy title, know the audience, bullet points, shorter paragraphs, inclusion of photos. You may also wish to outline guidance on typical length, we would recommend 500 -750 words for a blog and 2-3 minutes for a vlog		
<b>Planning and writing (20 – 30 mins)</b>	<p>Students should take this time to plan their work. they should be encouraged to think about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Their choice of topic, have they selected to discuss something that they consider to be a key milestone?</li> <li>- How they structure the piece to convey a clear theme/content</li> <li>- Have they linked their chosen topic to future ambitions?</li> <li>- Have they utilised the Ludus blogs for inspiration/guidance?</li> <li>- The language/tone they choose to adopt to resonate with their intended audience</li> </ul> <p>If students opt to create vlogs you may wish to split this activity over two lessons, allowing sufficient time to film and edit content between</p>	<p>Access to the LUDUS Website</p> <p>Pen and paper</p>	
<b>Pairs – marking (10 mins)</b>	<p>Ask students to get into pairs and swap their blogs/vlogs with each other. They should give at least 1 idea to help improve their partners work.</p> <p>Students should give each other constructive criticism on how to improve their work – not jus grammatical errors but the flow, the content and structure</p>	<p>Pen and paper</p>
