## **Regulation XXIV**

## Special Regulations for the Diploma in Economics

(Version effective from 1 August 2011 to 24 January 2024)

**1.** Further to para. 12 of Ordinance XXXIII, there shall be Programme Regulations to be read in conjunction with these Regulations.

**2.** The School of Business and Economics may admit to the programme students whose experience and qualifications are considered appropriate having regard to the nature and academic standard of the programme.

**3.** In order to qualify for the award of the Diploma in Economics, a student must have satisfied the examiners by accumulating credit in the assessment of modules in the manner specified in the Programme Regulations.

**4.** The assessment of each module shall be conducted by a Review Board constituted in accordance with the provisions of Regulation XXII and acting in a manner analogous to the procedure set out in Regulation XXI.

**5.** The Diploma in Economics will be awarded by Programme Boards constituted in accordance with Regulation XXII and acting in a manner analogous to the procedure set out in Regulation XXI.
