23/67 Minutes

Senate confirmed the minutes of the meeting held on 14 June 2023 (SEN23-M3).

23/68 Matters arising from the Minutes

<u>Effectiveness Review of Senate</u> (minute 22/39(ix) referred): "It was agreed that the issue of support for Senate members within Schools, including the potential for pre-Senate meetings and arrangements for disseminating Senate business would be discussed at the next Dean's Forum so that best practice could be shared."

This was discussed at the Dean's Forum meeting on 26 July 2023 and subsequently by email, and the following was noted:

i) Practice varied across Schools and ideas were shared as intended.

- ii) The business of Senate was disseminated in several ways, including by the Dean and/or School Senate members at staff meetings; in email bulletins; by the Dean to SMT with key points cascaded to all staff; in de-briefs with staff; and in Q&A sessions for substantial items.
- iii) Deans felt it was unnecessary to arrange formal meetings in Schools ahead of Senate meetings but did make themselves available to Senate members to answer any queries before and after meetings.

23/69 Research and Innovation Core Plan

SEN23-P81

Senate recommended to Council for approval the 3 Research and Innovation Core Plan objectives and the 6 Council Level key performance indicators (KPIs), respectively.

In discussion clarification was provided in relation to the first Council KPI for Objective 1 (R&I Focus): The increase in research awards targeted was deliberately stated as an equivalent market share, and the specific sum would therefore depend on the size of the market overall. Award value would be used as a leading indicator for this KPI due to the time-lag associated with counting income.
