



**What is Sexual Violence?**  
 Sexual Violence is any unwanted behaviour of a sexual nature which has the purpose or effect of violating the recipient's dignity and/or creating a hostile, humiliating or offensive environment.  
 It can take many forms and includes, but is not limited to: rape, sexual assault including groping, making unwelcome sexual advances, harassment including following, catcalling and wolf-whistling, stalking and displaying or sharing sexual material in shared spaces (physical or virtual).
